<p>If a student fails to submit homework:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.) Missing assignment notice sent home to the parent via agenda. Student has until the next class to turn in assignment. 2.) Teacher will determine if student will receive a grade penalty. 3.) If student fails to submit assignment by the next class the student is assigned AIP and given a red AIP card to take home to parents/guardians. 4.) Either Tuesday or Thursday the student is to report immediately to room E-6 with the missing assignment. 5.) The student has the right to decline AIP. If student declines to attend AIP he/she will receive an automatic zero for the assignment. Parents will be notified via phone, email, or agenda. 6.) If a student was assigned AIP and did not attend he/she will receive an automatic zero for that assignment and parent will be notified. 	<p>If a student fails to submit homework:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.) For the first semester, a missing assignment notice will be sent home to the parent via agenda. Student has until the next class to turn in assignment. 2.) Teacher will determine if student will receive a grade penalty. 3.) If student fails to submit assignment by the next class the student is assigned AIP and given a red AIP card to take home to parents/guardians. 4.) Either Tuesday or Thursday the student is to report immediately to room E-6 with the missing assignment. 5.) The student has the right to decline AIP. If student declines to attend AIP he/she will receive an automatic zero for the assignment. Parents will be notified via phone, email, or agenda. 6.) Students may use three AIP sessions per class for the school year. Once the third has been reached, that student no longer has the luxury of AIP for that class. 7.) If a student was assigned AIP and did not attend he/she will receive an automatic zero for that assignment and parent will be notified. 8.)
